The course outcomes are delivered through three sessions - Climate Justice & Education, Climate Justice & Intersectionality and Climate Justice in the Classroom.

## Course Outcomes:

- Increased knowledge and understanding of education about and for climate justice
- Increased awareness of and confidence to explore intersectionality and its relevance to the climate emergency
- Increased skills to promote critical thinking, debate and discussion on complex and controversial issues
- Increased confidence and motivation to plan lessons and include opportunities for young people to feel empowered to act and be heard in support of climate justice
